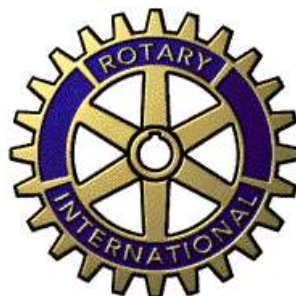

Young Regional School of Music tutors David Pereira (cello) and Katherine Day (piano) perform duos from Germany, Spain, Poland and Australia.

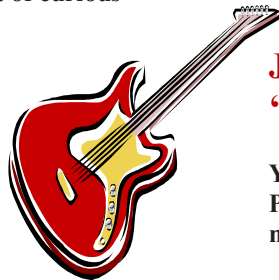
Don't miss these wonderful performers.
